As an Urban Designer and Landscape Architect, Leonard has thirty five years of experience in design of the public domain. Educated in Australia and Scotland he has worked in public sector planning and design agencies, universities, and in a range of private practice roles.

His project experience, teaching involvement and role as critic or commentator on design matters spans Britain, North America, Asia Pacific and all states of Australia. Leonard's work has won the recognition of his peers with awards from BALI, RAPI, AILA, LI, ACEA, UDIA, National Trust, LCA and the HIA in recent years. As director of CLOUSTON Associates, Leonard's work has taken him from development of landscapes for health care in the Central Desert, to regional Australia, to significant public sites such as Commonwealth Park in Canberra and Hyde Park in the Sydney CBD.

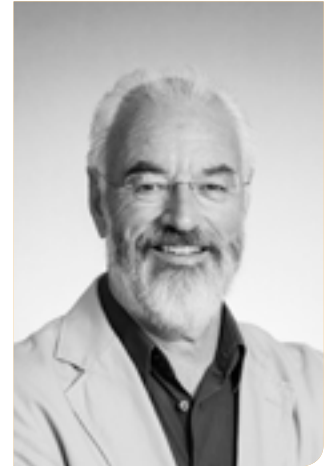
