Tony Cox is a Director of CLOUSTON Associates, having been a practicing Landscape Architect since 1986. Within CLOUSTON Associates, Tony has played a central role in a diverse range of planning and design projects undertaken across northern Australia, central Australia and South East Asia. His skill in drawing out the core principles and distinguishing characteristics of each project is firmly based on his understanding of landscape in the broadest sense and his focus on client needs and community aspirations. At the same time, he brings to every project a planning/design ethos based on local 'language' and design integrity matched with the best practise environmental outcomes.
